#### Who we are

The Infosys Science Foundation (ISF), a not-for-profit trust, was set up in 2009 by Infosys and some members of its Board with the objective of encouraging, recognizing, and fostering world-class scientific research connected to India.

The Foundation furthers its objectives primarily through the Infosys Prize, awarded to outstanding researchers and scientists in six categories. It engages with the public and academic communities at different levels to inspire young researchers and students to take up a vocation in the sciences and research.

## **Infosys Prize**

The Infosys Prize is an annual award, to honor outstanding achievements of researchers and scientists in six categories - Engineering and Computer Science, Humanities, Life Sciences, Mathematical Sciences, Physical Sciences and Social Sciences. Recipients of this annual award receive a citation from a distinguished international jury and a purse of 100,000 USD.

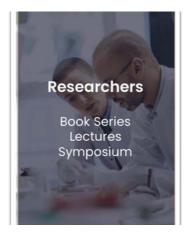


#### Communities we work with

The Foundation partners with educational institutions to host lectures featuring Infosys Prize laureates and jurors to spark curiosity and inspire the next generation of scholars. It engages with the general public in conversations around science and its impact on society, with educators through training workshops, with university students through lectures, summer schools and workshops.















### **About our space**

A part of our mission is to bring back the romance to research. We want to engage the public, students and the community at large in discussions and experiences that may provoke and encourage them to think critically and with curiosity about the world around us.

In keeping with this we provide a platform for dialogue between academia and the public. The ISF has created a space for such engagement at our office. We have floor space and an auditorium (100 seats) that we offer as an event venue for lectures, public talks, workshops, screenings and performances by academicians, artistes and like-minded organizations.

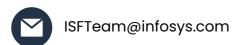
